NSE MD Chitra is 1st woman chief of WFE

New Delhi: World Federation of Exchanges (WFE), which represents nearly 45,000 listed companies, has appointed NSE's managing director and CEO Chitra Ramkrishna as its new chairperson.



WFE, which is the global industry association for exchanges and clearing houses, has appointed three new officers in line with the organisation's customary geographical rotation of office-bearers every two years. WFE has also appointed Urs Rueggsegger, group CEO, SIX, as its vice chairman, while it has named William Brodsky, executive chairman at Chicago Board Options Exchange, as the chairman of its working group committee.

"I am honoured to be confirmed as WFE chairperson, and look forward to working with my colleagues," Ramkrishna said in a statement. Her name was announced at the 56th General Assembly in Cartagena, Colombia, on Thursday.
